dla

Królestwa Galicyi i Lodomeryi z Wielkiem Księstwem Krakowskiem,
zawierająca postanowienia na wypadek, że poseł sejmowy ulegnie kondemnacji sądowej,
lub zostaje pod śledztwem sądowym.

Zgodnie z uchwałą Sejmu Mojego Królestwa Galicyi i Lodomeryi
z Wielkiem Księstwem Krakowskiem, rozporządzam, co następuje:

§. 1.

Poseł sejmowy, który za czyn karygodny ulegnie kondemnacji, pociągającej za sobą według ustaw utratę prawa wyboru i obieralności do Sejmu, traci tem samem i prawo uczestnictwa w Sejmie.

Podczas śledztwa karnego nie może on wykonywać funkcyi członka sejmowego, jeżeli Sejm w myśl ustawy z dnia 3. października 1861. r. (Dz. u. p. p. Nr. 98.), nie zażąda odroczenia śledztwa i zdjęcia aresztu, jeśli takowy zarządzonym został.

§. 2.

Niniejsza ustawa wchodzi w życie z dniem ogłoszenia.

§. 3.

Wykonanie niniejszej ustawy polecam Memu Ministrowi spraw wewnętrznych i sprawiedliwości.
