Dear Sir,

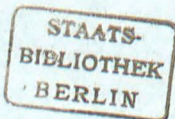

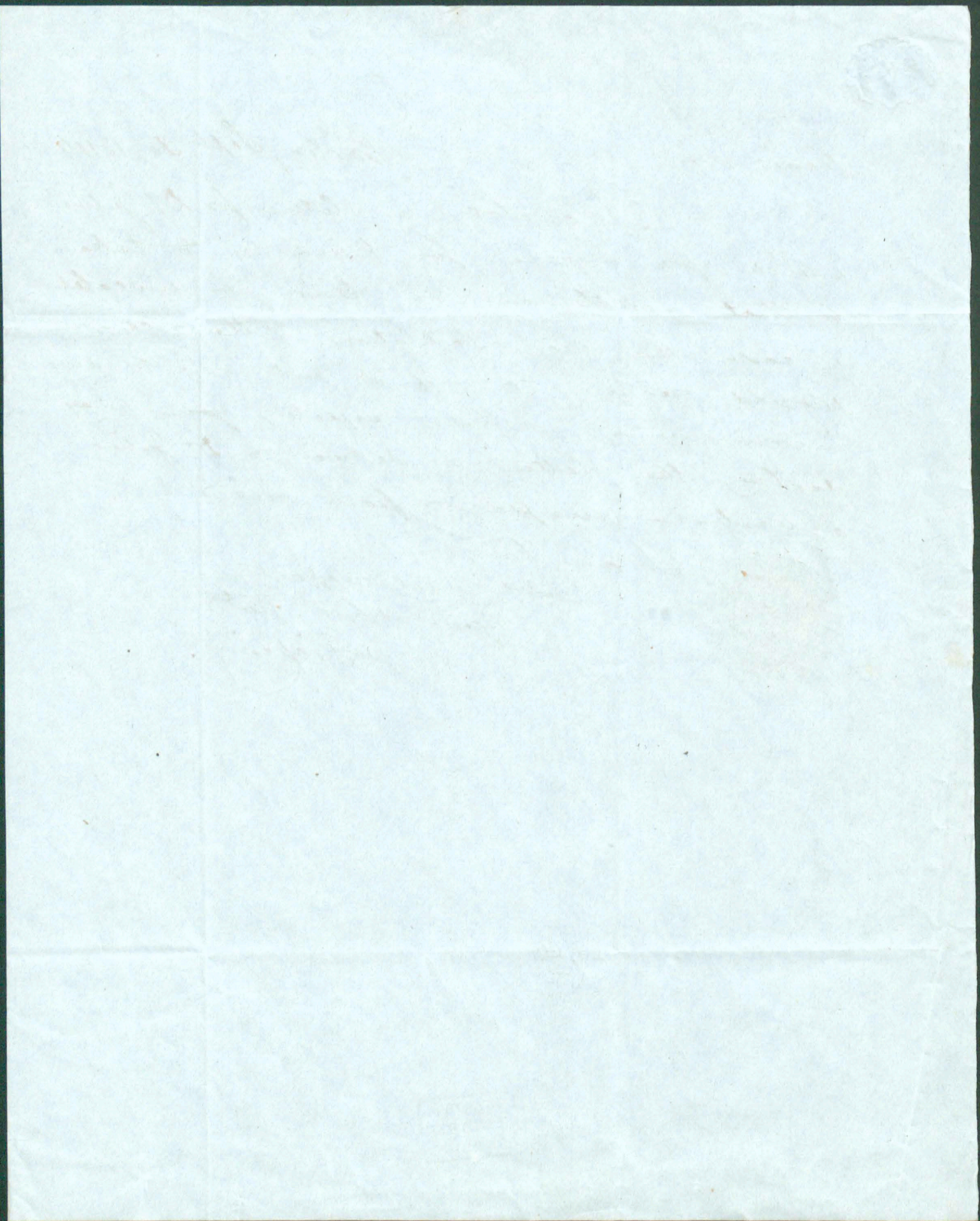

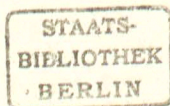
