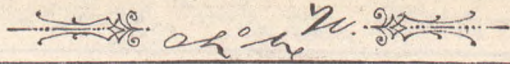

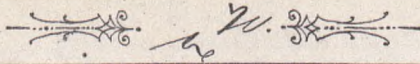
July 21, 1880.
