Easy-To-Make Christmas Project



Getting ready for Christmas can be fun for all the family with this beautiful easy-to-make nativity scene project. The most experienced home craftsman can put it together with just a few basic materials.

All that you need is a piece of 1/4-in. thick hardboard 14 by 21 inches, 3/4-in. square pine strips cut from scrap lumber, lath, 1/4-in. wood screws and brads, wal-nut stain and Elmer's Glue-All. For nativity figures, use air-drying clay (available at hardware and dime stores), poster paints, clear plastic spray, and sandpaper.

Lasting Beauty
To make figures, roll clay on wax paper to 1/8-in. thickness with rolling pin. Let clay dry then cut outlines of figures and animals with knife held in vertical position. Dip knife in water occasionally for smooth edges. Paint figures with poster paint, coat with dry plastic spray, then glue triangle supports to backs with Elmer's Glue-All.

Latest Books

The War Lover, by John Hersey (Knopf): A brilliant novel exploring the meaning of war to the warrior—specifically to the rare sort of soldier who genuinely enjoys combat. The narrator, and Lt. Boman, was co-pilot of the Flying Fortress commanded by Maj. William (Buz) Marrow, the finest, paunchiest pilot in the group. His story balances a minute-by-minute account of one climactic raid, the deadly, grinding strike at Schweinfurt in 1943, against the story of the months of flying, the 23 missions that led up to it. The Truman-MacArthur Controversy and the Korean War

The Truman-MacArthur Controversy and the Korean War, by John W. Spanier (Belknap-Harcourt): A scholarly study of the act that shook the nation in 1951—the firing of General MacArthur. Spanier, a political science teacher at the University of Florida, says that President Truman was right in removing MacArthur for challenging the government's political and military policy. But he adds that the Truman administration must share with MacArthur responsibility for the ill-fated march to the Yalu river in the winter of 1950-51.
