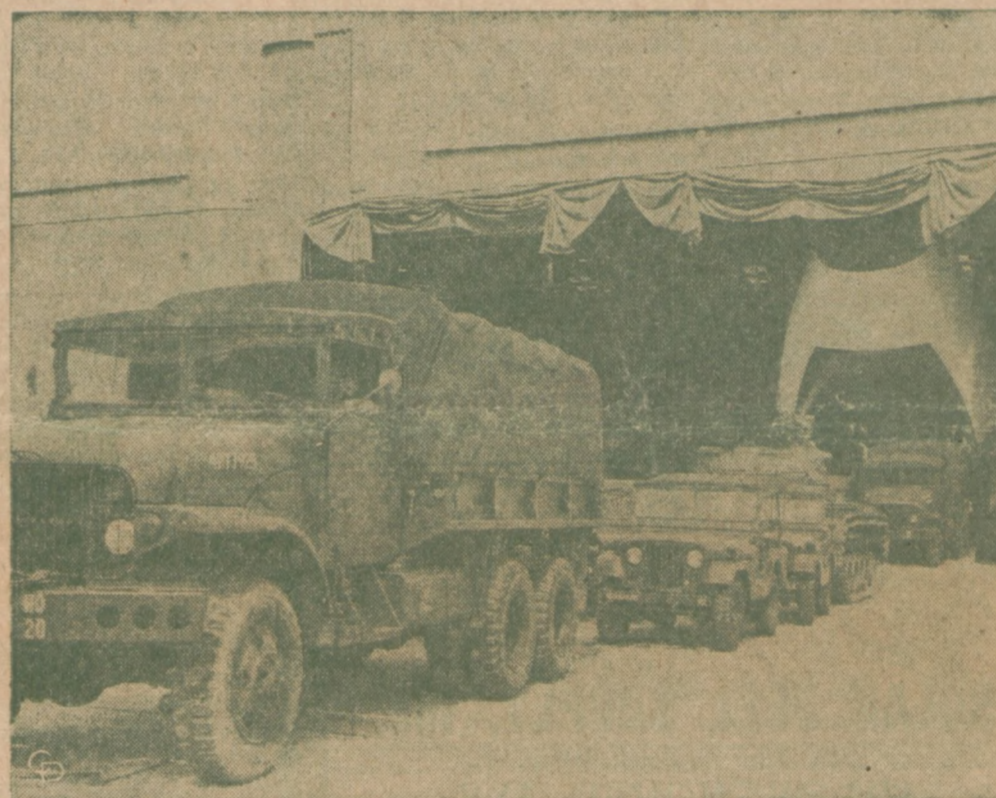

Washington (Sp.) A commemorative reception marking the 85th anniversary of the Polish National Alliance was held recently at the Capitol under the auspices of PNA Council 203. The use of the Capitol hall for this occasion was arranged by Congressman Joseph P. Vigorito, Democrat from Erie, Pa.

Postmaster General John A. Gronouski was scheduled to address the gathering. Due to another, unexpected assignment, Mr. Gronouski sent Wally Urman, president of Council 203 the following letter:

Dear Mr. Urman: I had planned and indeed hoped to be with you today, but, unfortunately, another important assignment prevents me from attending your reception. I hope you will forgive me and allow me to convey to you some thoughts which I had hoped to express to you personally.

First, I would like to extend my sincere thanks to Congressman Vigorito for all he did to help arrange this reception and to the Polish National Alliance for taking the initiative in making it all possible.

As you are well aware, a few months ago I accepted membership on the Advisory Council of Alliance College and on several occasions since then I have said that I am interested in the growth and scholastic progress of this prominent American institution of higher education.

Great Proposition

I believe we are now in the midst of one of the great eras of American history. To me, ours is an exciting, vibrant and creative age; an age that is building for an even greater future for our nation. We have embarked on one of the most ambitious youth and education programs in history. This government and this generation of Americans have committed their resources, their energy, their ideas and their hearts to the proposition that every child in this land shall have a chance to broaden his horizons and lead a decent, productive life. We have become fully aware that well educated youth is our fundamental resource and that our national destiny is in the hands of the young generation.

President Lyndon B. Johnson summed up an entire nation's determination when he declared recently that he wishes to see an America in which no young person, whatever the circumstances, shall be deprived of the education and skills that will give him the opportunity to be an effective citizen and self-supporting individual. And this means not

only grammar and high school, but college as well.

Tribute To Forefathers

Last year in my Commencement address at Alliance College I said that I place the highest value on education and I recalled to the graduates that our Polish forefathers, who emigrated to this country without proper school background and skills, nevertheless also placed the highest value on learning, knowing that if their children did not receive a sound education, they would not develop into responsible citizens able to take their rightful place in the communities of this great land. And they saw to it that their descendants did receive a good education.

And now the responsibility devolves upon us to give our children an even sounder and better preparation for the immensely challenging tasks which will face them in the near future.

It is for this reason that all of you present at this reception can take pride in Alliance College for its achievements and progress. And its long range plans should have the wholehearted endorsement of the Polish National Alliance and indeed the support of the entire country. In supporting Alliance College we are performing a vital service to our nation by opening new opportunities and new horizons for Americans of Polish, as well as other origins.

With this in mind, you have my best wishes for a most successful event.

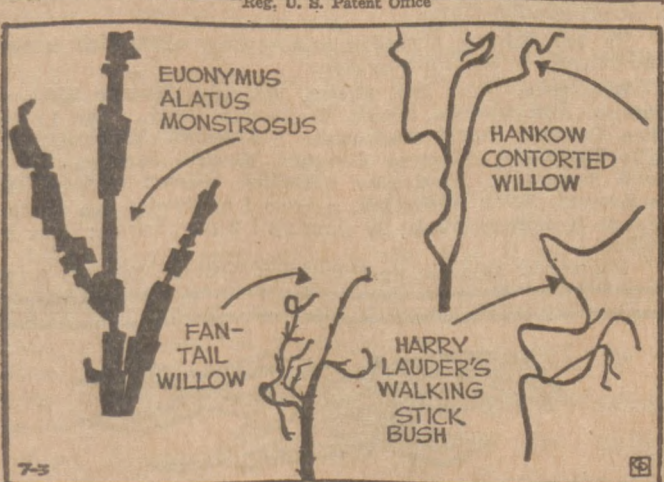

AS ONE becomes more interested in flower arrangements one tends to plant in his garden plant material which gives interesting or unusual designs. Many flowers can be grown or purchased from the florists. However, this is not true of foliage or branches. The only way to have them is to grow them. As shown in the accompanying Garden-Graph, there are several shrubs which are easy to grow and which have branch irregularities. The winged, or corkbarked, euonymus alatus monstrosus makes an unusual and ornamental shrub. Its branches are popular for use in flower arranging. Final Details Being Completed For Visit Of Poland's Primate Cardinal Wyszyński, To U. S.

"Most of the final details for the forthcoming visit of Poland's Primate, Stefan Cardinal Wyszyński, to the United States in 1966 have been completed," stated The Most Reverend Aloysius J. Wycislo, Auxiliary Bishop of Chicago and Pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, who is in charge of the Cardinal's itinerary. Bishop Wycislo further stated "Canada has been included, where in both Toronto and Montreal, the Primate will be the guest of His Eminence Paul Emile Leger, Archbishop of Montreal."

DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS: Following his arrival in New York, on or about August 24, 1966, Cardinal Wyszyński will go immediately to Chicago where he will participate in a huge outdoor spiritual convocation commemorating Poland's Millennium of Christianity. Over one quarter-of-a-million Chicagoland Poles plan to overflow Soldier's Field to pray with the Cardinal, hear him speak. He will also participate in an outdoor field Pentecost Mass. Many members of the American Hierarchy are expected in Chicago on August 28, 1966, when the gigantic event takes place.

Other Mid-western areas include visits to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where His Excellency, Archbishop William Cousins will be host and in Green Bay, the Most Rev. Stanislaus V. Bona will be host there for a brief sojourn. In the Archdiocese of Detroit, the Cardinal will be the guest of His Excellency Archbishop John Dearden, where a local Committee is planning a Millennium Celebration in Detroit's Cobo Hall Convention Arena. The Primate will rest a few days at St. Cyril and Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, Michigan.

After this hiatus, Cardinal Wyszyński travels to Philadelphia where His Excellency Archbishop John Krol has arranged a full six-day program. Philadelphia's Convention Hall has been set for a Pontifical Mass and sermon by the Polish Primate plus a spiritual convocation at Independence Square to be followed by a formal dinner. The Wilmington (Delaware), Camden, (N. J.) and Allenton and Scranton, (Pa.) areas are included in the Philadelphia program.

The Washington, D. C.-Baltimore, Md., sojourn includes visits with The Apostolic Delegate to the United States, The Most Rev. Egidio Vignozzi; His Eminence Lawrence Cardinal Shehan of Baltimore and the Most Rev. Patrick A. O'Boyle, Archbishop of Washington.

In Cleveland, Ohio, the Committee of Priests in charge of observing Poland's Millennium of Christianity is working closely with the Officers of the Polish Roman Catholic Union (a Catholic fraternal insurance organization which is holding its annual convention in that city at the same time) to provide a four-day visit is being worked out for the Polish Primate.

A possible one or two day visit is being considered for the Pittsburgh area. Cardinal Spellman Extends Invitation

nal McGuigan with His Excellency, the Most Rev. Phillip F. P. Cooch have elegant plans in the making.

His Eminence Richard Cardinal Cushing is directing a program for the Polish Primate during his stay in the Boston area. A committee of Polish priests are making extensive plans to fete Cardinal Wyszyński. A visit to the Stockbridge, Massachusetts, headquarters of The Marian Fathers has been included just prior to Cardinal Wyszyński's return to Poland about the middle of October, 1966.

Between August of 1965 and August of 1966, many of the diocese included in the Cardinal's itinerary and others, that, with due regard for the Primate's time and health, could not be included, are conducting intensive spiritual preparation to culminate the celebration of Poland's One Thousandth Birthday of Christianity in 1966.

Bishop Wycislo has announced that Chicago Radio-TV and newsmen Sig Sakowicz has been appointed National Chairman, Press, Radio and TV for Poland's Millennium of Christianity.

TIMELY TOPICS

July In American History

First Republican Candidate

On July 13, 1890—John Charles Fremont, first standard bearer of the present Republican Party, died in New York City. A native of Georgia, Fremont won national fame for his explorations in the Far West, which earned for him the nickname of "the Pathfinder." He played a leading and controversial part in the conquest of California during the War with Mexico. Nominated for the Presidency in 1856, Fremont lost the election by more than 500,000 popular votes, but through his personal prestige and dignified campaign put the Republican Party, then just newly organized, on the map. At the outbreak of the Civil War, Fremont was appointed major general in charge of the Department of the West. He later served as territorial governor of Arizona.

Owen Wister

On July 14, 1860—Owen Wister, author of a famous Western story, The Virginian, was born in Philadelphia. Wister was a close friend of Theodore Roosevelt, and his writings reflect many of the first President Roosevelt's interests and attitudes. Though The Virginian seems somewhat old-fashioned to the contemporary reader, it is an interesting and revealing picture of American life in the West at the end of the last century. It is generally considered the first full-length "Western" novel. Several motion picture versions of the book have been made and it is still an outstanding example of the popularity of American "Westerns." Originally a lawyer by profession, Owen Wister also wrote several other volumes of biography and fiction, among them, The Modern Swiss Family Robinson, Red Men and White and Lady Baltimore. He died July 21, 1938, a week after his 78th birthday.

Atomic Age

On July 16, 1945—in a remote section of the Alamogordo Air Base, 120 miles southeast of Albuquerque, New Mexico, the first atomic bomb exploded at 5:30 a. m. on the top of a steel tower. A blinding flash, brighter than the brightest daylight, a tremendous sustained roar, a huge multi-colored cloud boiling up to an altitude of more than 40,000 feet—thus the atomic age began. The blast, which left a huge crater where the steel tower once stood, fused the earth's surface, shattered windows a hundred miles away.

Three weeks later the world knew that the atomic era had opened when one bomb destroyed the center of Hiroshima, a busy city in Japan, killing thousands of its people. Since then the world has been trying to find answers to the moral and military problems created by the atomic bomb.

Conference at Potsdam

On July 17, 1945—the so-called Big Three Conference opened at Potsdam, near Berlin following the unconditional surrender of the Third Reich in World War II. It was attended by President Truman, Prime Minister Churchill, and Premier Stalin, as well as other top ranking officials of the three powers.

Important questions before the conference were a plan for the occupation and control of Germany, the settlement of various European problems, the trial of war criminals, reparations, and the question of national frontiers.

The Potsdam Conference ended on August 2, 1945. During the conference, the United States, British and Chinese governments issued an ultimatum, called the Potsdam Declaration, to the Japanese government, calling on Japan to surrender unconditionally and defining the circumstances under which a final peace

Orthodox Church In Poland

Warsaw. (IC)—The faithful of the Orthodox Church in Poland settled after the war all over the country. For the purpose of pastoral care, Poland was divided into four dioceses: Warsaw-Bielsk, Bialystok-Gdansk, Lodz-Poznan and Wroclaw-Szczecin. There are 203 parishes in those dioceses, serviced by more than 200 priests. The Orthodox clergy is educated in two schools at Warsaw: the Major Religious Seminary and the Christian Theological Academy, which has all the rights of a school run by state. There are at present 40 seminarians in the Major Religious Seminary. They also study at the Orthodox Department of the Christian Theological Academy.

On May 26, 1965, the Autocephalous Orthodox Church in Poland obtained a new head in the person of the newly elected Metropolitan of Warsaw and All Poland, Archbishop Stefan Rudyk. He was elected by the council of the Orthodox bishops of Poland. Metropolitan Rudyk, who was interned during World War II by the Rumanians and Germans, returned to Poland after the end of the hostilities. He first worked in the Lodz-Poznan diocese. In 1953 he became Ordinary of the Wroclaw-Szczecin diocese. Immediately before his election to Metropolitan, he was ordinary of the Bialystok-Gdansk diocese.

The enthronement of Metropolitan Rudyk at the Warsaw Orthodox cathedral (which is in the suburb of Praga) will take place on July 18. Representatives of all the Churches composing the Polish Ecumenical Council, the Patriarchs of Constantinople, Greece, Moscow, Bulgaria, Yugoslavia and Rumania, and the Metropolitan of Czechoslovakia have been invited to the ceremonies.

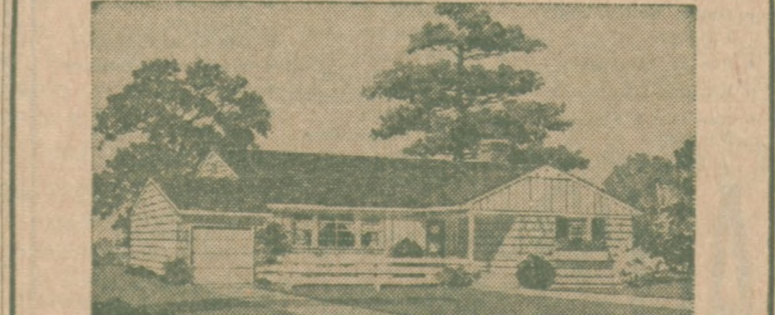
