Today's Sportrait

New York (UPI) — There are few athletes who would forsake the glamour of a professional football career for the hectic life of Madison Avenue, but ex-grid star Alex Kroll is one man who is happy to have swapped his shoulder pads for a grey flannel suit.

Kroll was an All-America center at Rutgers University during the Scarlet Knights undefeated season of 1961 and was the No. 2 draft choice of the American Football League's New York Titans, who later became the Jets.

After signing for a modest bonus, Kroll became a regular on offense for the Titans during their 1962 campaign and by the end of the season seemed well on his way to becoming one of the league's better tackles.

Kroll, an extremely intelligent man, discussed the problem with his wife and decided to quit football and take a steady job with Young & Rubicam, with whom he had worked part-time since his graduation.

After starting as a "junior, junior club copywriter," he was promoted to regular copywriter and soon afterward hit upon an idea that blossomed into one of the biggest advertising campaigns of this past year — the 2,500-year-old brewmaster.

There are so many people involved in a campaign that big it would be unfair for me to take all the credit for it," Kroll said.

Good ideas in advertising are rewarded by big promotions and Kroll has since moved up to the position of supervisor. It is a very challenging job involving the direction of writers and artists and it is the only one which allows him to work with all types of media.

The greatest weakness my staff has encountered are a lack of experience and a lack of depth. Last year's fine team was a predominantly Senior squad. Because most of the games were close, the Juniors didn't see much action.

He also enjoys talking about his season with the Titans despite the fact the team's 5-9 record was the worst in the club's six-year history.

"We didn't even have a line coach," Kroll said laughingly. "And we didn't have any projector to show game films. I was moved from center to tackle in the third quarter of the San Diego game. And I asked the coach, Bulldog Turner, what to do on pass blocking. He told me to just hit the man in front of me. It makes me laugh when I read about how much trouble Francis Peay and Don Davis (rookie tackle) for the New York Giants are having on pass blocking.

"I've thought about writing a book on that season" Kroll continued.

Kroll, 28, lives the life of a commuter now. He resides with his wife and young son in Wilton, Conn., which is a far cry from the hotel rooms of professional football league cities.

"It's tough to come down from all the glamour and the public eye," Kroll admits. "But I know I made the right decision. It would be tough for me to run a trap play on Saturday again."

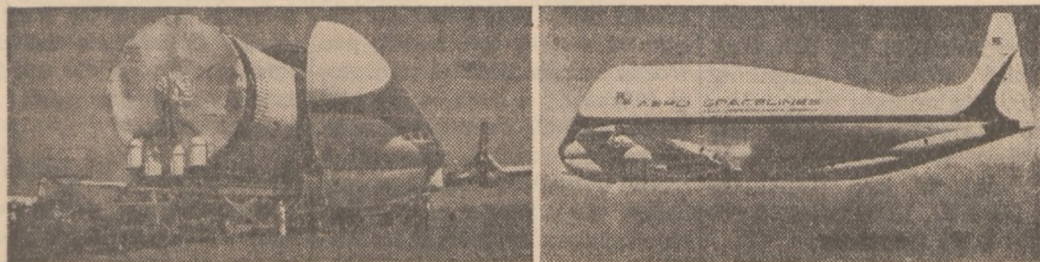

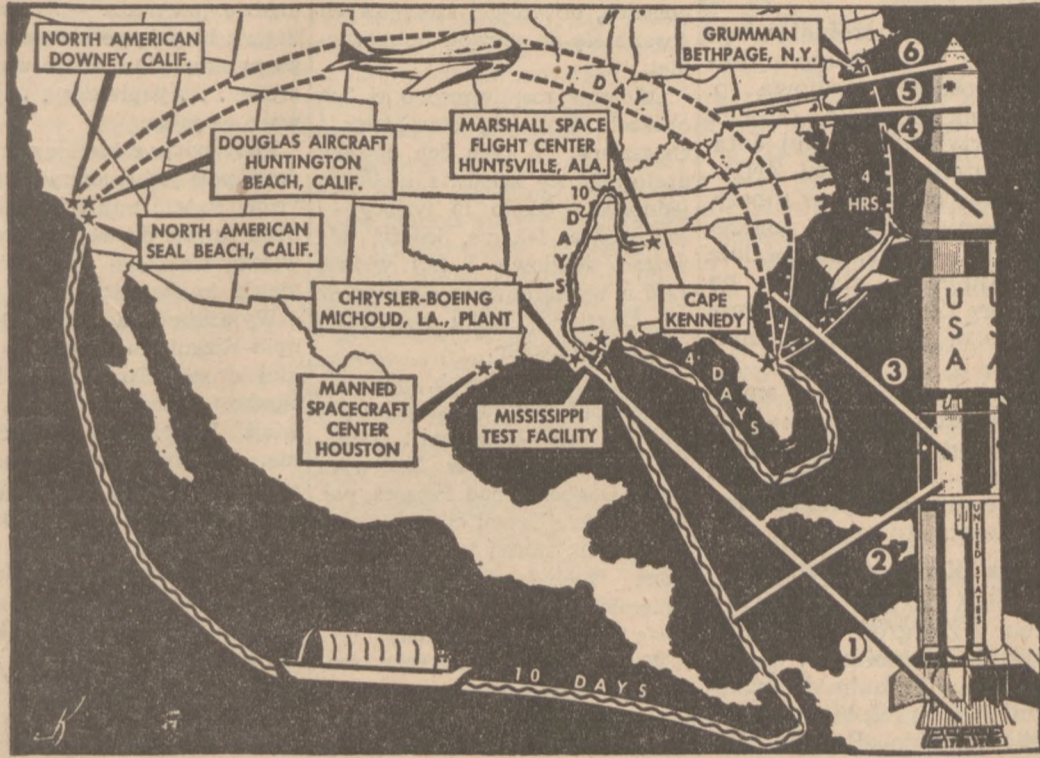

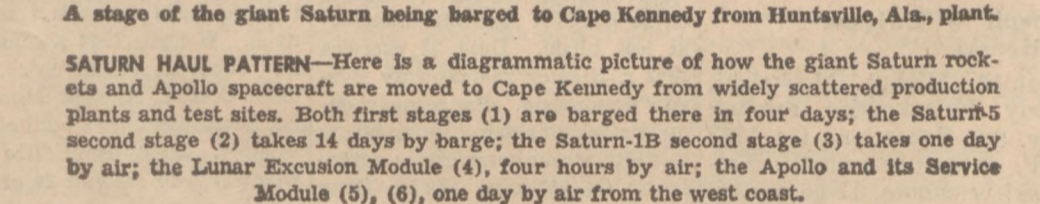

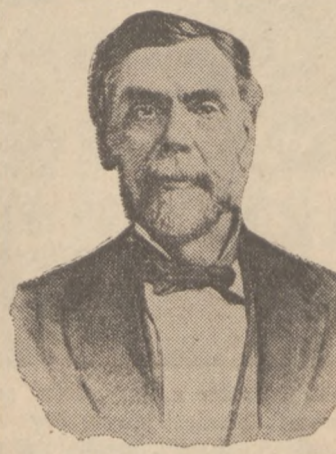
