Krzysztof Penderecki

Europe's Most Impressive New Voice In Modern Music

Warsaw (IC) — The monumental masterwork of the 33-year-old Catholic Polish composer Krzysztof Penderecki, "The Passion According to St. Luke," has met with enormous success. The premiere performance of the "Passion" took place in the cathedral of Munster, West Germany. The first performance in Poland was held in Krakow, at the Wawel Castle, on April 22, 1966. Since that time both in Poland and abroad that magnificent religious composition is gaining increasing universal applause.

IN VENICE: An indication of the increasing popularity of the "Passion According to St. Luke" was given at the last International Musical Festival in Venice. The concert of the "Passion" took place at the close of the Biennale on September 14. Though at the Venice Festival the general public is usually not represented in large numbers, the church of San Giorgio was filled to overflowing with an enthusiastic audience during the performance of the "Passion." Among the many flattering opinions, "Il Popolo" had this to say: "The magnificent, dramatic 'Passion' and Death of Jesus Christ According to St. Luke" by the young Polish composer Krzysztof Penderecki closed the XXIX International Festival of Modern Music in Venice. One could speak here about almost a revelation, about a new authentic composer of sacred music, if we had not already said those things last year on the occasion of another musical festival, when Penderecki presented his "Stabat Mater." It is a work with such a charge of religiousness and of such dramatic tension as one very rarely meets."

IN KRAKOW: Five concerts have taken place so far. Several days before each one of them, all the tickets were sold out. In Krakow the "Passion" was recorded in the ancient Gothic church of St. Catherine which has ideal acoustics. The regular and boys' choirs of the Krakow Philharmonic and its orchestra, 212 persons in all, took part in the recording session. The firm "Polskie Nagrania" has already started selling the records, while the tape with the recording was sold to the foreign firm "Philips."

IN WARSAW: The "Passion" was performed for the first time in Warsaw on September 24 in the auditorium of the National Philharmonic during the "Warsaw Autumn" (an annual international festival of modern music). The enthusiasm with which the people of Warsaw greeted the performance of the "Passion" can be gleaned from the reviews in the various newspapers. Said the Zycie Warszawy in its issue of September 26: "The Philharmonic has not seen such large crowds as it saw yesterday. Last evening half of Warsaw

wanted to listen to the 'Passion' of Krzysztof Penderecki. Another success for that young Krakow composer." In its next issue the same paper returned to the subject saying: "The 'Passion' of Krzysztof Penderecki was a great event of this year's 'Autumn.' Enormous interest, a storming of the box office, and later of the Philharmonic doors; an ovation which lasted ten minutes. The work of the young Krakow composer making him a world figure..."

In the near future the "Passion According to St. Luke" will be performed in Rotterdam, London, Rome and Buenos Aires.

EDITOR'S NOTE: Weekly news magazine Time wrote in its Music Section of October 14:

In Krakow, so many people showed up that an additional performance had to be scheduled to accommodate the 10,000 ticket seekers. In Warsaw, one of the biggest crowds ever to pack National Philharmonic Hall cheered and clapped for ten minutes. In Venice's San Giorgio church, where applause is forbidden, clergy and audience alike burst into a spontaneous ovation that one priest excused as "homage our Lord would surely want us to pay." The acclaim was neither for a renowned soloist nor an old master, but for the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ According to St. Luke by Polish Composer Krzysztof Penderecki, Europe's most impressive new voice in modern music.

Austerely contemporary in sound, Penderecki's two-hour oratorio draws on a wide musical spectrum ranging from pious Gregorian chants to the dry linearity of the twelve-tone school. In a fresh departure from the Passions of Bach and Telemann, his chorus participates as well as comments, punctuating Christ's ascent to Calvary with hisses, shouts and mocking laughter, while the music quavers and sighs in sympathetic counterpoint. With the lean, clean strokes of a fencer, Penderecki slices to the heart of the Passion, revealing through the intolerance shown to one man the tragedy of all men.

Saws & Sirens. Passion is Penderecki's latest and most ambitious work. Now 33, he leapt into prominence seven years ago when he anonymously entered three compositions in a competition sponsored by the Polish Composer's Association — and walked off with first, second and third prizes. The first performances of his music in Poland were attended by hard-core traditionalists who touched off riots with whistles and rattles. Penderecki merely answered with some noise-makers of his own, scored one piece for woodwinds, musical saws, files, sirens, typewriters and electric bells, not to ignore the percussionist whose work entailed assaulting a log with a handsaw.

Millenium In Ohio Alliance College Kujawiaki Will Take Part In Program

Cambridge Springs, Pa. — Monsignor Thaddeus Heruday, Chairman of the Polish Millennium Observance Committee of the Diocese of Youngstown, Ohio, announced today that the committee will present the Alliance College Kujawiaki as part of their celebration of the Millennium on Sunday, October 23, in Stambaugh Auditorium. The public is cordially invited to attend and no admission will be charged. The program will begin with Holy Mass at 5:00 p.m. The Mass will be recited in English, and a 200-voice choir will sing traditional Polish hymns during the Mass.

Following Mass, the Alliance College Kujawiaki, a group of undergraduate singers, dancers and musicians from Alliance College in Cambridge Springs, Pennsylvania, will appear fully-costumed in procession and then present a program of Polish national and country dances. The group is under the direction of choreographer Jan Sejda.

The engineers figure that hundreds of thousands of persons must have walked over the lethal weapons, each containing seven pounds of TNT, since they were buried.

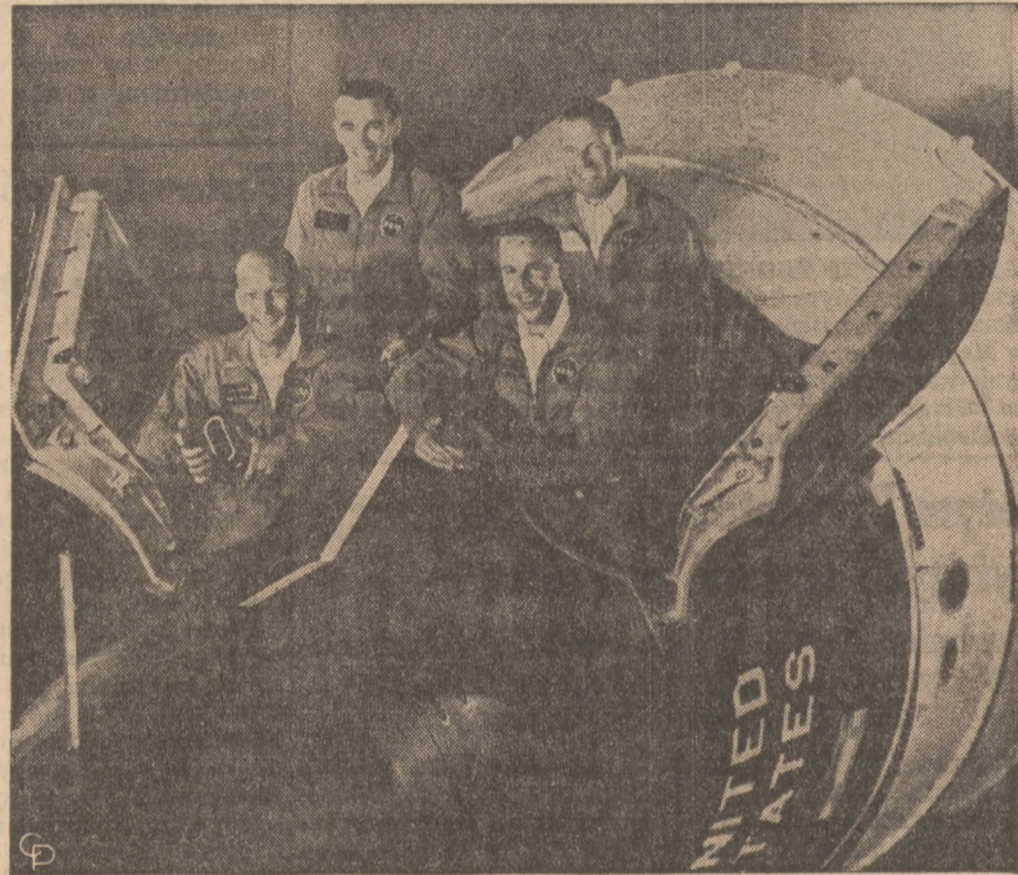
Luminescent Ink For Stamps

Wild Geese Begin Fall Migration

Of all the migrant birds, the wild goose seems most to typify the restless spirit of autumn. A part of this comes from the fact that geese are big, spectacular birds and travel in flocks, often huge flocks. But another part is the garrulousness of geese. Most birds travel in silence, but not the goose. In the air or on the water, it chatters and gabbles, gossips and confers. Geese are not reticent birds.

YOU BEGIN to hear and see them now, moving down by stages from the north. In a city street, a suburban dooryard or at a rural roadside, you hear the distant clamor. It seems to echo from the whole sky. You look up, searching, and at last you see the penciled "V," high against the blue, arrowing southward.

OR YOU STAND beside a quiet pond or lake in late afternoon and hear the chatter, like the distant yapping of small dogs. Then you see them coming in over a hilltop, a dark cloud of them, to circle once then drop, long necks outstretched, wings cupped, feet thrust, to land in a rush of spray.

WHEREVER YOU see them, they are something special. The sky is theirs, and far places. They come from over the horizon, like autumn itself, and tomorrow or next week they will be following summer southward again. And earthbound you will have the haunting memory, the faint echo of wild geese chatter high overhead, to remind you of autumn's footloose travelers, the proud talkative, far-ranging geese.

Explain Use Of Voting Machine

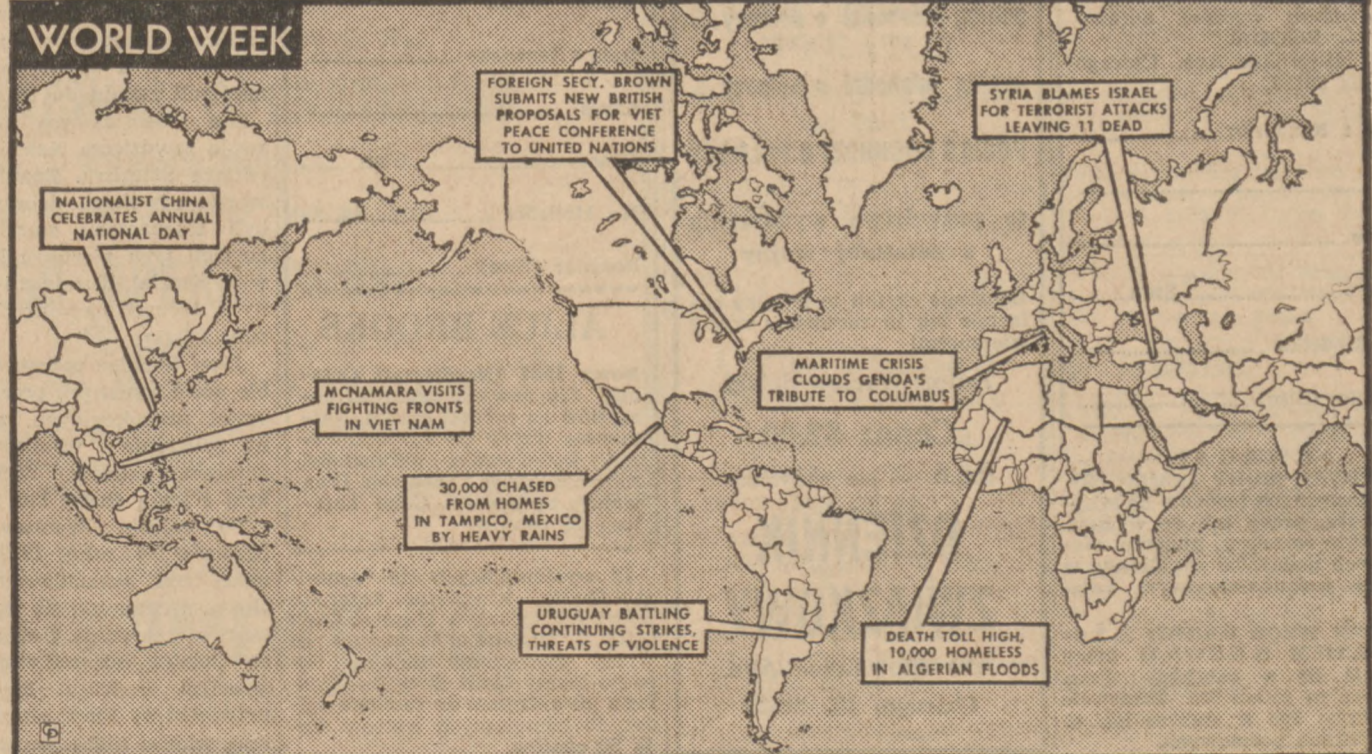
