Two Women's Colleges  
Announce Fall Openings

Los Angeles (Sp.) — Openings for approximately 400 women students were announced this week by Marymount College, Palos Verdes Estates, California and its new affiliate, Marymount International College.

The expanded capacity is keyed to recently-announced plans to move Marymount College to the Campus of Loyola University of Los Angeles, and to establish the new international institute on the present Palos Verdes campus.

Marymount-at-Loyola will admit approximately 150 additional students who are aiming toward bachelor's and more advanced degrees.

Marymount International College will admit about 250 young women to its unique two-year program of cultural interchange among young women from all parts of the world.

DURING THE COMING year, both colleges will share Marymount's present campus, on a cliff overlooking the Pacific Ocean in the Los Angeles suburb of Palos Verdes. In September, 1968, the four-year college will be transferred to a new facility adjoining that of the long-established men's college in Playa del Rey.

Cats Pictured  
On Polands  
Stamps

Warsaw (Sp.) — Cats are among children's best loved animals. Polish children, also make pets of cats and sing songs about them. Perhaps the most popular lullaby in Poland is about two grey kittens, so that children here even from early infancy already gradually become acquainted with this particular animal. There are also many beautifully illustrated children's books about cats. Janusz Grabiański, a Polish artist who is famous in the country and all over the world for his drawings of animals, sketched the picture of the cat for a stamp.

In Poland Today  
High Chimney Will Not  
Solve Air Pollution

Warsaw (Sp.) — In the extremely difficult field of building industrial chimneys, Poland is included among the "big five," along with the USA, Japan, the Soviet Union and the German Federal Republic.

The problem lies in the "chimney sound barrier" which appears at the height of approx. 656 feet. Exceeding that height requires a radically different design beginning with the foundations construction, and ending with the technology of finish. Polish engineers, among very few in the world learned all the secrets of building extra-tall industrial chimneys.

RECENTLY THEY proved this by building Europe's highest, approx. 833 feet, for the Siersza II power station. This chimney was a real sensation in the engineering world, attracting many delegations of specialists from Yugoslavia, France, Bulgaria, Sweden, the German Democratic Republic and other countries.

Without going into the technical details, it should be stressed that in building that giant, unique technical solutions were used, as well as an ingenious assembly method utilizing steel scaffolding with a self-climbing head. The chimney has a diameter of 85 feet at the base and around 25 feet at the top. Since ventilators will pump 30,537 cubic feet of combustion fumes per second at a temperature of 338 degrees Fahrenheit, the whole length of the chimney was lined with heat resistant materials. It may be interesting to note that more than 23,000 tons of building materials were used for the construction and that the top may swing up 6'6" from its vertical axis.

THE SIERSZA plant will burn approx. 5,000 tons of coal daily, yet because of the more than 850 feet high chimney, the dust and gases will be almost completely absorbed by the air and spread

over such a wide area, that their harmfulness will disappear. (Like Americans, Poles will eventually find out that high chimneys are not the permanent answer to industrial air pollution).

Msgr. Casaroli  
Ends Visit  
In Poland

Rome (IC) — Monsignor Agostino Casaroli, Undersecretary of State for extraordinary ecclesiastical affairs, returned to Rome, after completing his third visit to Poland.

Msgr. Casaroli visited many Polish dioceses. As a guest of the individual bishops, he also met with the regular and diocesan clergy, visited religious seminaries and spoke with Catholic laymen, in order to become acquainted with the whole complex of religious life and conditions in Poland.

AS REPORTED by the News Service of the U.S. Catholic Conference, official Vatican sources regularly emphasized during Msgr. Casaroli's stay in Poland that he did not hold talks with the official representatives of the regime.

Msgr. Casaroli himself (according to the USCC News Service) refused to confirm or deny a report in the usually well informed Catholic daily of Bologna "L'Avvenire d'Italia," that he had talks with the representative of the Polish Communist party, Stefan Werblan. The same daily also reported that Msgr. Casaroli confirmed that he had not yet begun formal talks, nor made official contacts with any personalities of the regime, with the exception of courtesy visits.
