They come from various sources — they are answers to the public inquiry on "Polish Help to Jews," published in 1963 by Wladyslaw Bartoszewski in "Tygodnik Powszechny," the Catholic weekly appearing in Krakow, they are communications sent to Mr. Bartoszewski from various parts of the world, from European and non-European countries in connection with his journalistic activities; they are texts which were published in periodicals or documentary books in the early post-war years but are now difficult to get at.
